Server Explorer

Object Browser
Sort and customize objects across all languages.

Dynamic Help
One-click access to pertinent help based on the developer's task at hand.

Enhanced Toolbox
In addition to offering new components for Web, Windows, and data development, code snippets can now be dragged to the toolbox for later reuse.

Visual Studio Macros
Enable developers to rapidly customize the behavior of Visual Studio .NET to fit their specific needs.

Debugger
Single unified debugger works across all languages that use the Common Language Runtime. Allows developers to set conditional breakpoints and persist them across sessions.

Task List
Lets developers annotate their code so that they can keep track of areas that need attention. Jump to a TODO comment simply by double-clicking it.

Outlining Code
Select a region of code and hide it to improve readability. Expand the code by double-clicking.

Class View
Graphically displays a hierarchical view of namespaces, classes, methods, and functions.

Command Window
Allows direct interaction with the IDE from the keyboard, dialog boxes, windows, and other items using keyboard shortcuts.
